Growth & Challenges | David McCrary

February 14 marked the beginning of the sixth year of our school and what a great year it is. We now have 270 wonderful children receiving an education daily. That is an increase of over 60 from

last year. This means more than 60 children need sponsors now.

We have 35 new 3 year olds plus several children in each of the 3rd, 4th, and 5th grades which were not full last year. Then, there are always a few who have moved away and that space is given to another child. In addition to the regular curriculum, these children eat a nutritious meal daily, they get vitamins daily, they brush their teeth, and most important, they learn from God's word daily.

We know that without this school many of our children would not attend any school due to the very poor condition in their homes. The poverty often creates dysfunction and it greatly affects the ability of the children to learn and to socialize with their peers. Due to this, we have a psychologist who works with many of our children and this year we have increased her schedule to 2 days weekly. She has already been a tremendous blessing to many of our children and their families

Very Important!!!

Our school could not function and these children could not be there without their sponsors. We now need sponsors for more than 60 children. It costs \$30 monthly to sponsor their education and \$10 monthly

for their food. You can do either or both for a total of \$40 per month per child. When you sponsor the education of a child (\$30 per month) you have a specific child who you can support as long as they attend our school. You will get pictures, a small amount of information about their family, and from time to time a sample of their work.

What an opportunity for you to touch the life of a child, to help them to provide for themselves and their families, and to teach them about Jesus Christ. You can change the future for this child, not only here on earth, but for eternity.

On March 9th, I had the privilege of going to the Nicaragua Christian School in León, Nicaragua. I had been the previous year, but those kids and that place shows me something new every time I go. Nicaragua is a very different environment than I'm accustomed to. As citizens of the United States, we live in a place where having electricity is as easy as flipping a switch and running water is regarded as a daily necessity. Most Nicaraguans don't share those same luxuries. While in León, I was able to see how Nicaraguans lived, and I realized how truly lucky I was. I also realized how selfish I was. Those children have almost nothing, but they are so incredibly joyful. They see things like going to school and brushing their teeth as privileges; whereas, I see them as grievous chores. I have been blessed beyond belief and still find reasons to complain. I came to show God to those people, but they ended up teaching me things about my faith I never knew were possible. The children's love was incredible, and I will always remember who they are and how they made me feel. Nicaragua is part of me, a part I will never forget.
