What a blessing it was for me to be in Nicaragua while the JCS students were there and get to witness how much their young people speaking different languages and from very different cultures encouraged and inspired each other. As one of the chaperones put it, "all of the children and teens were singing with their heart, not worrying about anything else and I looked around and knew GOD was there."

Chaperones and faculty also participated in assisting the faculty of NCS. There were in-services held one afternoon for both preschool teachers and also grade school teachers. Educational tools were donated to NCS to help with mathematics instruction and demonstrated by teachers present during the secondary school in- service.
