For the seventh consecutive year, the Salem Creek church of Christ in Murfreesboro, Tennessee, conducted a "Vacation Bible School" at Nicaragua Christian School. This year thirty-six made the trip. The Bible school, which ran June 20 - 24, set attendance records for this annual effort. The low attendance was 230 on Sunday with the high being 401 on Monday. On Tuesday there were 302; VBS closed on Wednesday with an attendance of 390. The local church and the people at Nicaragua Christian School did a great job of promoting VBS.

This year we also enjoyed a couple of other important opportunities. Along with children from Nicaragua Christian School, our group visited a nursing home in Leon. The residents enjoyed being entertained by the children from the school. It was a blessing to the children and to our group to be able to visit with the residents.

Our group donated around fifty coloring books to the school. The children from NCS performed for the children at the "special needs" school and did a tremendous job. The children at this school are blessed to be given an education by dedicated faculty and staff members who obviously love them. 
